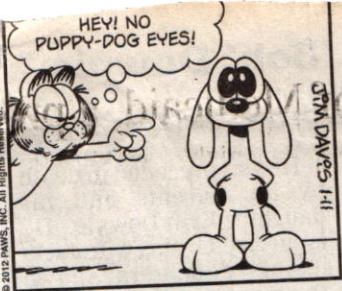
The funeral service will be held Friday, January 13, 2012, at 2:00 p.m. at the First
