

Maxine E. (Kirkpatrick) White

June 13, 1917-March 4, 2010

KENNEWICK, Wash. — Maxine E. (Kirkpatrick) White, 92, of Kennewick, Wash., died Thursday, March 4, 2010, in Kennewick. Graveside services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday, March 12 at Olney Cemetery in Pendleton.

Mrs. White was born June 13, 1917, in Pendleton to Earl and Gladys Kirkpatrick. She had one brother, Donald. She was raised on a farm near Pendleton and helped feed harvest crews. She married Floyd Farrell in 1940 and had three children.

She married John White in 1952 in Idaho. They moved to the Tri-Cities area and had two children. The whole family of seven

briefly lived in West Richland, Seattle, Sunnyside, and Burbank before settling in Kennewick in 1964, where she dedicated her life to her family.

Mrs. White is survived by her loving husband of 57½ years, John; children Mike, Pat, Judy, Don and Connie; seven grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.
