

Kathy Dale Andersen McCormmach

March 12, 1949-July 20, 2010

VANCOUVER, Wash. — Former Pendleton resident Kathy Dale Andersen McCormmach, 61, died Tuesday, July 20, 2010, at Southeast Washington Hospital in Vancouver, Wash. At her request, no services will be held. Private interment will be conducted at Olney Cemetery in Pendleton.

Ms. McCormmach was born March 12, 1949, at the Pendleton Maternity Hospital. She attended Pendleton schools, graduating from Pendleton High School in 1967. She later attended the University of Oregon in Eugene. She married Morrie McCormmach in Texas during the Vietnam War; they later divorced.

She was employed by Olear and Howard Garage and the Oregon State Forest

Service in Pendleton. She later moved to the Federal Highway Department in Vancouver, Wash., where she retired in 2004. From 2004 until June of 2010 she worked as a medical transporter.

Ms. McCormmach is survived by her brother, Terry Ray Andersen of Pendleton; aunt Mae Andersen Larson of Eugene; uncle Jack Andersen of Eugene; and six nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Georgia Mae and Raymond Dale Andersen; and sister Trudy Jane Andersen Capon.
