Barbara Ann Campbell of Pendleton passed away Saturday, February 9, 2013 surrounded by her family at her home. She was 65 years old.

The couple resided in Pendleton, OR. After obtaining her LPN license she worked at St. Anthony Hospital in Pendleton for the following 10 years. After 43 years of service at St. Anthony's, she retired November 15, 2011. Barbara always put the needs of her family first. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church, enjoyed spending time with her family and grandchildren, gardening, and traveling to various destinations including one of her favorite destinations of the Oregon Coast.
