PENDLETON—John Venard Catterall, 93, of Pendleton died Thursday, Jan. 28, 2010, at his home. Visitation will be held from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Thursday, Feb. 4 at Pendleton Pioneer Chapel, Folsom-Bishop. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. Friday, Feb. 5 at the funeral home. Burial will follow at Olney Cemetery.
