Virginia Lynne Erickson, 68, of Olalla, Wash., died peacefully April 28 in Bremerton, Wash., surrounded by her family after a courageous nine-year battle with ovarian cancer. Services were held May 11 at St. Nicholas Church in Gig Harbor, Wash.

Graveside services will begin at 11 a.m. June 16 at Olney Cemetery in Pendleton.

Lynne was born Aug. 1, 1943, to Betty V. and Thomas L. Faulkner in Yakima, Wash. The family moved to Pendleton then to La Grande where she graduated from La Grande High School in 1961.

Growing up in La Grande, Lynne was a saxophone player in the pep band and a member of the choir. She was a Union County fair maid one year. She said she built wonderful, lasting relationships with "the gals" in La Grande

In 1964, Lynne graduated from Yakima Junior College with her LPN. She enjoyed being a nurse at various hospitals and retirement centers.

Lynne married John J. Erickson on Sept. 7, 1963, in La Grande and lived in Yakima, Wash., until moving to Seattle. They eventually settled in Olalla to raise their children, Nichole and TJ.

Lynne was an active member of the community from being a Camp Fire leader to a member of the Seattle chapter of National Foundation of Ileitis and Colitis (now Crohn's and Colitis Foundation). She owned Children's Bear Essentials and The Dance Shop. She belonged to Port Orchard Chamber of Commerce, Relay for Life, Soroptimist International of Port Orchard and Tacoma Orthopedic Association where she founded the Betty Faulkner Guild, named for her mother.

Lynne enjoyed volunteering for anything, baking, crafting, gardening, golfing and spending time with her grandsons, Alex and Noah.
