Eunice L. Hascall, 85 of West Birch Creek, Pilot Rock died Monday, November 24, 2014.

Together Wayne and Eunice started a rental properties business they worked tenaciously to expand to several units. She continued to oversee and run this until her passing.

In her later years, she enjoyed playing pinochle with family, collecting dolls, gardening and watching older western movies. She was an animal lover, taking in stray or injured animals of all kinds and nursing them to health. Eunice also enjoyed spending time in the mountains, fencing, mushroom hunting and checking on cattle.

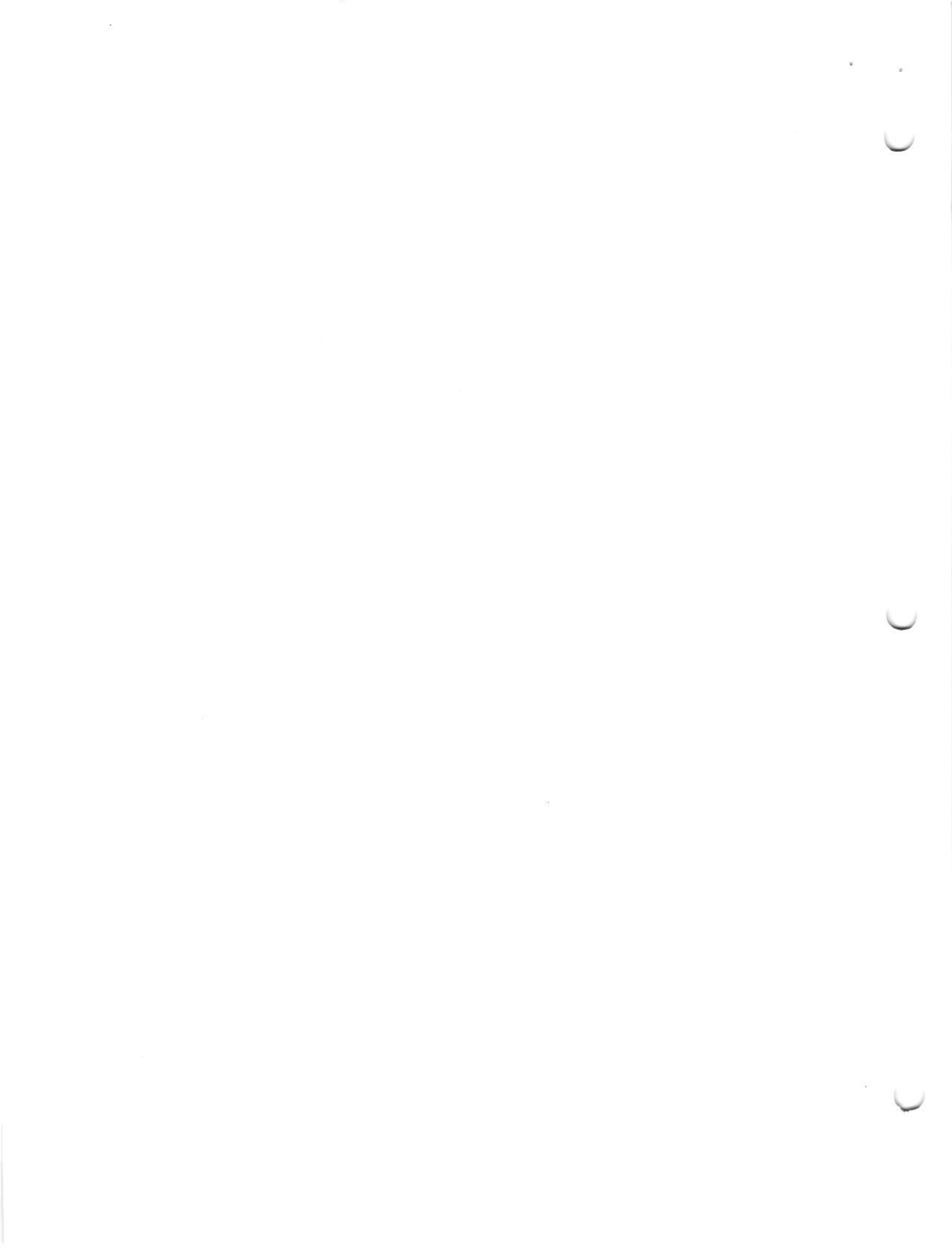
