PENDLETON — Gladys Pearl Jones, 84, of Pendleton died Wednesday, Sept. 29, 2010, at a local care facility. Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m.

Wednesday, Oct. 6 at the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in Pendleton, with interment following at Olney Cemetery.

Mrs. Jones was born May 1, 1926, in Eleva, Wis., to Jul H. Julson and Mabel Calista

Breese, one of seven children. Her father was a farmer. During the Depression the family had to leave their farm in Wisconsin, moving to White Bluffs, Wash., which later became Hanford, Wash. She later relocated to Corrine, Utah. She married LaMar Jones in Elko, Nev., in 1946. She and LaMar became members of the Church of Jesus

Christ of Latter-day Saints, and were sealed in the Logan temple in 1966.

She worked as a pilot car driver, and as a cook for the Umatilla County Jail and

Camlu Retirement Community. She also spent many years ironing for the community of Pendleton.

Mrs. Jones is survived by her sister Margaret; son LaMar Jones; daughter Melissa Bush; four grand-

children; and two great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents; brothers Paul, Harry and Jimmy; sisters Hilda and Lola; and husband LaMar Jones.
