PENDLETON — Mary L. Ledbetter, 93, of Pendleton died Thursday, April 1, 2010, at Suttle Care Retirement Home in Pendleton. Mass of Christian burial was celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday, April 5 at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Pendleton, with interment following at Olney Cemetery. Recitation of the holy rosary was held at 7 p.m. Sunday, April 4 at Burns Mortuary Chapel in Pendleton.

Mrs. Ledbetter was born Jan. 19, 1917, in Pendleton to Fred and Josephine Price. She attended school at Cayuse and Adams, graduating from Adams High School. She attended college in La Grande at La Grande Normal School, where she attained a teaching certificate. She then taught two years at the Cayuse School. In 1938 she married Lyle L. Ledbetter, and the couple moved to Cayuse to farm with her father. In 1985 they retired from farming, and in

1989 moved into Pendleton. Mrs. Ledbetter is survived by sons Larry of Cayuse and Bill of Pendleton; daughter Karen Kell of Beaverton;
