Hans Unrau, born on 5 May 1935 in Hamburg, Germany, returned to his Heavenly Father on 15 June 2014. Hans grew up in Germany during WWII, and his childhood home was occupied by the British Army. When he was 19, he joined the German Merchant Marines and sailed from Poland to South America. In 1957 he immigrated to the United States and joined the US Airforce. In 1958 he met his sweetheart, Tina Patricia Guy, whose father was also stationed at Stead Air Force Base near Reno, Nevada. They married in 1962 and lived in Reno, where all three of his children were born. Except for six-months in Elko, Nevada, Hans and his family lived in Reno until 1981, when he moved the family to Pendleton, Oregon. There he built and operated Shop 'N Go convenience store on Southgate, where he worked over the years until he sold it. He joined The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in 1997 and served for 8 years with Tina in the Columbia River LDS Temple.
